<p>Create your own model of an ancient Mayan monument/temple.</p> 	<p>Create your own Mayan mask using materials of your choice.</p> 	<p>Visit Cragside in Northumberland and find out what you can about Hydropower. How does this work and why is it renewable/sustainable? Present your findings to the class.</p>
<p>Create a game/toy using an electrical circuit e.g. buzz wire game, clown with a light up nose, light up ladybug.</p> 	<p>Design and make your own chocolate bar, with packaging included.</p> 	<p>Make your own Mayan hot chocolate or guacamole.</p> 
<p>Research the game of football played by the Maya civilisation. Can you recreate this with family members? Can you invent your own ball game with your own rules?</p> 	<p>Find out who invented the lightbulb. Create your own project about this person and their invention to present to the class (this could be a computer based presentation, or a collection of images, written facts).</p> 	<p>Use decorated hard boiled eggs to recreate an element of the Easter Story (e.g. palm Sunday, The Last Supper, Passover, Exodus, Jesus Parting the Red Sea).</p>
