Subject	In school learning	Remote learning		
English	This week we will continue our focus on the book Heart and the Bottle by Oliver Jeffers. We will have less lessons this week as one lesson will be given to a poetry assessment, which will aim to assess your child's knowledge of things covered so far this year. *whilst these lessons are going on, children will be assessed in their knowledge of "high frequency words" and the Year 3/4 "common exception words" - these have been uploaded to the Year 3 website for you to look at with your child. You can read along with the book here; https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pi RPnKhdWpU The sequence of lessons being covered this week is; 1. To select adjectives for a known character and understand the spelling rules for words ending in -ous. 2. To describe a known character using a range of devices. 3. To sequence key events from the story.	 Ask your child about words ending in -ous and tell then that these words can sometimes be used as adjectives e.g. curious, tremendous, courageous, outrageous, serious, spontaneous, suspicious, cautious, wondrous. Using the story, can children draw the girl and place -ous words around the picture to describe the girl. If they wish to include words that do not end in -ous that is fine. Children will use the -ous words gathered from the task yesterday in order to write a descriptive paragraph of the girl. Children will also use their previous learning about the prefixes un, dis and mis to help describe the girl. Using the "bare bones" sheet that I have uploaded to the class page, the children will write a basic sentence in each box to sequence the story from beginning to end. Can children begin sentences with conjunctions such as "but" or use adverbs such as "eventually" and finally"? 		
	Reading At school, children will be participating in their group reading session, once a week.
