

The Roman Empire started in Rome, Italy.




















The Height of the Roman Empire

Why do you think the Romans didn't conquer the entire U.K.?




- This map shows the country boundaries as they were in AD 177.
- Have a look in your atlas. Which present-day countries were conquered by the Romans?


