Subject Outlines	Key Dates/Events: yoga all half term, stay and play 16 <sup>th</sup> -20 <sup>th</sup> Oct Topic Driver-Understanding of the World/personal and social Literacy-Listens to and joins in with stories, holds a book and turns pages, gives meaning to the marks they make Communication & Language-shows interest in songs, listens to others in small groups Maths-Discuss their house door number, uses some number names accurately in play, uses different shapes in their play, recites numbers in sequence PSED-separates from carer with support, can play in a group, awareness of nursery rules and routines Physical Development-uses one handed equipment with some control, can manage own hygiene, Understanding the World-Talk about own homes, enjoys playing with small world toys, notices features of their own environment, remembers and talks about significant experiences in their lives Expressive Arts & Design-joins in with familiar songs -shows an interest in how instruments sound -beginning to make believe by pretending	Key Dates/Events: 9th Feb-Valentines Disco, Flora singing Topic Driver: Personal and social/Communication and Language Literacy -shows awareness of rhyme, recognises rhythm in spoken words, suggests how a story might end, describes main story settings Communication & Language-focusses attention, talk about how and why things happen, uses vocabulary about things that are important to them, Maths-compares groups of objects saying more, less the same, separates a group of objects in different ways, shows an interest in representing numbers, use positional language, orders items by size PSED-can play in a group and keep the play going, carry out small tasks Physical Development-practice balancing, catch a large ball Understanding the World-talks about different people in school and at home that help us Expressive Arts & Design-dance to music, construct using different blocks and tools, sing familiar songs	Key Dates/Events- Topic Driver: Understanding of the World Literacy -enjoys a range of books, links sounds to letters, writes own name Communication & Language-uses vocabulary linked with experiences, introduces a storyline into their play Maths-recognise numerals I-5, links numbers to groups of objects PSED-aware of boundaries in nursery, be kind to others Physical Development-use simple tools, writes letters, moves in different ways Understanding the World-shows care for living things Expressive Arts & Design-use a narrative in play, choose colour for a purpose
