E.g. five trees/cars/bins/lampposts etc • Look around your house for number 5 - can you find it on a clock/cooker/tv remote etc? • Set a five minute timer on your grown ups phone and see what activity you can do in that time - can you draw a picture/do an obstacle course/get dressed etc • Do lots of five actions e.g. hold up five fingers/five claps/jumps/steps/hops /stretches/waves etc • Get a grown up to hide lots of number 5's around your house and see if you can go on a number hunt
