Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparing quantities using language such as big, little, large and small while describing items in the classroom/outside 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use language such as big, little, large and small generally throughout the day • Can you go on a hunt around your house and find things that are big/little/large/small? • At your teddy bears picnic, have some big/small items and give them to the big/small teddy bears - which teddy has the biggest/smallest items and why? • Using sand or water, can you fill different sized buckets/containers - which one holds the most/least?
