Literacy/ Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading the Man on the Moon - making aliens with 4 eyes/legs/heads etc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch the video Man on the Moon https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Rt5zQ1UO6rE • Singing songs about Space - 4 little men in a flying saucer etc • After watching the story, discuss with a grown up what you would take with you if you went to space. Can you hunt around your house and pack a bag of things you would take? • After watching the story, find a page in the book with aliens - talk with a grown up about the aliens - how many eyes/arms/heads/noses do they have? Could you have a go at drawing your own aliens with 4 eyes/arms/heads/noses etc? • Have a look on Tapestry for some jobs we will be doing at school that you can join in with • I will put some songs on Tapestry for you to sing about space!

E.g. four trees/cars/bins/lamposts etc • Look around your house for number 4 - can you find it on a clock/cooker/tv remote etc? • Set a four minute timer on your grown ups phone and see how many bricks you can stack, jumps you can do, steps you can take etc • Do lots of four actions e.g. hold up four fingers/four claps/jumps/steps/hops etc • Here is a song to watch about squares https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jOr2eRBluUs • Can you find some shapes in your house

Knowledge and Understanding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exploring space linked with our book this week 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a look at the rocket in the story, can you draw a rocket like the one in the story? Can you draw another rocket with 4 windows and boosters? Make a space sensory tray to explore - use some flour/oats and sprinkle in some glitter and shiny stars - make some marks in it or if you have figures at home, use them to pretend you are on the moon! Make a rocket using some plastic bottles and silver foil - can you pretend you are blasting off to space by counting down 5,4,3,2,1...Blast off! Watch this video about astronauts up in space https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=e3za6ITfFWk&t=284s Can you build/make a vehicle that you could use to travel in space and on the moon? I would love a photo on Tapestry to see what you made! When it is dark (which thankfully for this job is very early!), wrap up warm and go outside in your garden and do some star gazing - what can you see in the sky when it is dark? Can you see stars, the moon or some moving space stations?
