<p><b>Knowledge and Understanding/ Creative</b></p>	<p>Finding out about pigs Painting, drawing pigs Exploring different types of homes from around the world Experimenting to find the best material for the 3 pigs house</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use the internet or books to find out facts about pigs, make a poster to share these facts with me-draw pictures, ask you adult to help with the writing</li> <li>• What is your favourite farm animal? Can you draw or paint it for me?</li> <li>• Find different materials on your house that you might build a house for the 3 pigs with-use a hair dryer or blow rto see if any of the materials move e.g.kitchen towel, a plate, a towel, a shoe etc</li> <li>• Play a guessing game with a grown up.Ask them to describe different farm animals for you to guess e.g. I lay eggs, go cluck what am i?</li> <li>• Play a farm animal listening game by clicking this link</li> </ul>
