It will be held from the 11th of June to the 11th of July 2021.

24 teams will take part.

The teams have been split into six groups.

The matches will be played in 11 different cities. The first match will happen in Rome. The last match will happen in London.



Each team could win a lot of money. They will win more money if they stay in the contest for longer. The winners could make up to 34 million euro.

●	Group B	Denmark, Finland, Belgium and Russia
●	Group C	The Netherlands, Ukraine, Austria and North Macedonia
●	Group D	England, Croatia, Scotland and Czech Republic
●	Group E	Spain, Sweden, Poland and Slovakia
●	Group F	Hungary, Portugal, France and Germany

Where Will the Matches Take Place?

The matches will be played in 11 cities across Europe. This is the first time that this has happened and it is to celebrate the 60th birthday of the competition. The cities are:

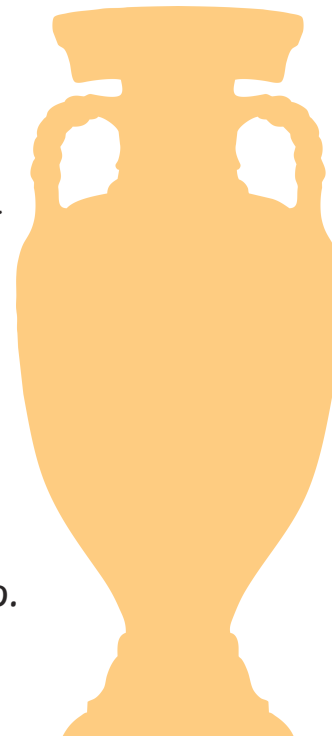
- ⚽ Amsterdam in the Netherlands

- Budapest in Hungary
- ⚽ Copenhagen in Denmark
- Glasgow in Scotland
- ⚽ London in England
- Munich in Germany
- ⚽ Rome in Italy
- Saint Petersburg in Russia
- ⚽ Seville in Spain

The opening match will happen in Rome. The semi-final and the final will take place in London. All other places will host three group-stage matches.

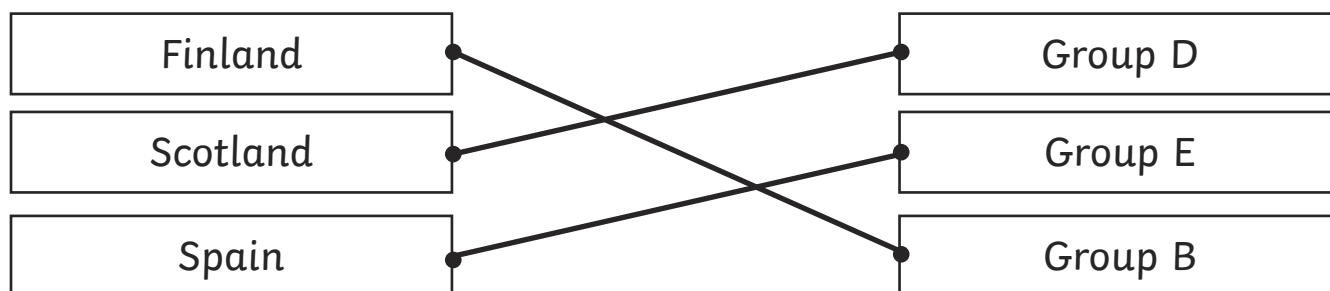
