When you get to zero, jump in the air to pretend to blast off! • Sing some number songs all about space. I have put the links to these on the website • Count some underpants! Make 10 different pairs of underpants by drawing them on paper and decorating them. Make 10 of these and see if you can count them all. Write the numbers 1-10 on some

Check you have them by placing them on the numbers and counting them with your grown up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go on a colour hunt! Find me 1 item that is pink, 2 items that are white, 3 items that are orange, 4 items that are blue and 5 items that are yellow. Ask your grown up to send me a photo of all of your items
