Can you research a type of reusable energy? Simply type this into Google and tell me what you find!	Research Forrest Green Football Club. Why are they a peculiar football team?	Times tables practice! Create a booklet to practice your 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 and 11 times tables. Use this to help you practice them in future!
Can you create a collage to show a light source in action? This could be the sun hitting a picturesque hillside or a lamp shining in a dark room.	Think of an endangered animal. Can you create a model at home of this creature in its natural habitat?	Can you write a poem about climate change? Your work in class might help you to do this.
What is Holi? Can you use paint to create an image of the scenes during a traditional Holi celebration?	Be a magpie word maestro! When reading at home, create a bank of possible magpie words to share with the class in our English lessons. Maybe you could create a jazzy poster!	Write a letter to Mrs Dowdney.
