Subject	In school learning	Remote learning
English		
Writing	We will be practising basic writing skills such as editing and improving writing. We will use photos and videos as a stimulus to generate ideas for shared writing.	<p>I can see.. I can hear.. - can children use the pictures as stimulus to generate ideas for writing? Can they make notes of what they can see or hear? Can they think about using similes, adjectives, adverbs and powerful verbs to describe what they can see/hear? Can they use the ideas to write a short description of the pictures?</p> <p>Uplevelling sentences- can children improve the sentences by adding vocabulary or changing the structure of the sentences?</p>
Spelling	We will be revisiting previous spelling rules from the year and looking at spellings from the year 4 spelling list.	Can children look in their reading record for past spellings they have found difficult? Can children test themselves on spellings from the year 4 spelling list? A copy of this can be found on the year 4 page of the remote learning section of the website.
Reading	As well as reading our class text, we will be reading some short comprehension texts linked to our learning on Anglo-Saxons.	There are a number of reading comprehension texts on the website.
Handwriting	We will continue with our daily handwriting practice sessions.	<p>Can children practise writing this week's spellings?</p> <p>Can children copy a part of their favourite book from home?</p> <p>There are some handwriting sheets on the remote learning page of the website to use as an on-screen reference or print if you wish.</p>

Maths	<p>Shape - angles and triangles</p> <p>This week we will be looking at angles in shapes. We will be recognising and labelling angles.
