What's on the Tray? Instructions

Before the Activity

- Prepare and cut out the words.
- Find a tray or use the tray picture below.
- Find a piece of material or paper to cover the words.

How to play:

- 1. Place a number of Word Cards on the tray.
- 2. Allow the player(s) a certain amount of time to read and remember the words on the tray, e.g. one minute.
- 3. Cover the items on the tray.
- 4. Ask the player(s) to recall all of the items they can remember. The player who remembers the most words wins!


Challenges:


- Ask the children to write down the real words they remember.

- Remove one of the items from the tray. Uncover the remaining items and ask the player(s) which item is missing.

















